Notes to equestrian participants: there are four horse camps, each with four stalls. The stalls share common walls, and that can be a concern with some horses.

Although formal proof of vaccinations is not required for this site, the veterinarian on call wishes to advise SCA equestrians that West Nile vaccinations are recommended in the area of this park this year.

If you are bringing four horses, you will be assigned one of these camps. If you are bringing less than four horses or more than four horses you may be assigned to share a stall group with other participants. There is no electric fencing permitted, but if you have a portable corral that has rails (such as round pen panels, other pipe pen panels, or the aluminum portable panels sold for camping, all minimum 4' high please) you can bring your own and we can assign a spot in the horse camp for your corral. Please indicate this on the pre-registration form.

There is a reasonable amount of room for camping in the horse area for those who wish to camp near their warhorses. Two camping sites are available per four-stall group plus there are several other lawn-like areas to use. The permanent stalls have chain gates that will keep in most horses (see note about ponies below) but some of the S-links are broken or bent — the equicrat will have a supply of fasteners and baling twine to use if needed. There is potable water available in several faucets in the horse area. The permanent stalls allow the stretching of tarps over them — the weather may be inclement (this is Oregon in the fall, after all) so please consider either bringing tarps to use (20' x 30' works) or rain sheets for your war horses. The equicrat will have some extra rain sheets for emergencies, but may not have your horse's size available.

The site's lovely trails and enclosed ring are part of the park's public equestrian area, but per the new AnTir (and SCA) equestrian rules are not available to SCA equestrians unless they are accompanied on the trail or at the ring by an AnTir equestrian marshal (junior or senior). Please coordinate trail rides with the EMIC so that an equestrian marshal may accompany you and a radio be assigned to them for emergency use. Please also be courteous to any non-SCA day trip equestrians also using these facilities — this is a chance to let them know about the SCA in general, our local branches, and also to invite them to observe the scheduled SCA equestrian events.

Areas subject to SCA insurance and rules requiring the presence of marshals and **not** shared with the public are:

- (1) the horse camp (everyone camping in it needs to sign equestrian waivers)
- (2) the SCA specific warm-up and equestrian competition areas (within the plastic flagging)

Please follow the marked path from the horse camp to the SCA or park equestrian areas. Horses are, alas, not permitted in the main camping areas, even for progresses or processions. Your pre-registration packet will include park, SCA activity, and horse camp maps.

Pre-registration

Fill out one copy of the Equestrian pre-registration form for each group bringing horses to the event.

There is a \$10 charge (\$15 at gate) for each horse brought to Acorn XIX. Also, all equestrian participants **MUST** pre-register. We encourage payment with pre-registration since both horse and human fees will be higher at gate.

Please **PRINT CLEARLY** and **LEGIBLY**. You may photocopy the form, but do not reduce or enlarge it. Do not substitute or staple the form.

When we receive your registration, we will mail back a postcard acknowledging your Equestrian registration. Please bring this card with you when you arrive at the gate. Forms should be postmarked by August 30, 2008.

Please include all necessary waivers (adult non-member waiver, minor waiver for children and youth) and the equestrian waiver (roster style). Please note that parent or guardian must sign the equestrian roster style waiver as "parent or guardian name" and (following line) "as <parent or guardian> of <child or youth name>"
